Policy on In-person Meetings During COVID

Effective August 24, 2022

Wearing masks and being vaccinated is a way to protect ourselves, our fellow Rotarians, and their families. We have members who have loved ones who are at high risk because of pre-existing conditions, and we need to do our part to take the necessary precautions to protect each other.

When the Lincoln-Lancaster County COVID dial is in the yellow or orange range, Lincoln South Rotary Club will continue to meet both in person and on Zoom. Should the COVID dial reach the red range, meetings will only be conducted on Zoom (See speaker link in our Club newsletter or website for details on joining the meeting).

Protocols for Meeting In-person:

- 1) Masks will be required by all in-person attendees, except when eating or speaking from the podium.
- 2) No person will attend if they are showing signs of illness or symptoms related to COVID 19 or its variants. As a courtesy to other members, following an illness or symptoms we ask that you be tested for COVID before attending a meeting.
- 3) People attending in-person need to be fully vaccinated. People unvaccinated will attend by Zoom only. This includes our speakers.
- 4) Meeting cost of \$17 is required to attend a meeting. The meeting cost will be paid only online at the Lincoln South Rotary website.
